1st place prize money of 400.00 € and a gold medal 2nd place prize money of 200.00 € and a silver medal 3rd place prize money of 100.00 € and a bronze medal

#### Pair ranking:

Ball prizes for 25% of the participating couples with at least the first three places.

Protests:

Protests against referee decisions must be submitted to the chairman of the jury in simple written form no later than 15 minutes after the end of the game on the respective competition day and must be negotiated by the responsible jury on the spot immediately after the end of the game.

The jury's decision must be immediately communicated to the protester, the tournament director and the (overall) tournament director. Decisions of the jury on appeals against arbitration tribunal decisions must be announced immediately.

Miscellaneous:

All registered participants must report their attendance to the tournament office between 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. on Friday.

The match reports are provided by the organizer.

In addition, the DMV sports regulations, including additional and implementing provisions, and the international rules of the game apply.

The DMV anti-doping regulations, in particular the anti-doping guidelines in the currently valid version, are recognized as binding upon registration for participation.

Each participant (player, referee and other tournament officials) is responsible for complying with these regulations and must bear the consequences of violations.
